

In-Person Worship Guidelines and Expectations

1. If you are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, aches, cough, etc.), we ask that you remain at home until it is safe to rejoin us.
2. Masks will be required to be worn at all times while in the building (the only exception will be those singing in the praise team while offering music and those offering the message for the morning).
3. If you do not have a mask with you, the church will provide one for you.
4. If you cannot wear a mask, we politely ask that you consider worshipping from home for everyone's safety.
5. We ask that if you are serving during worship in any role (music, sound/tech, ushers, check-in), you plan to arrive no later than 9:30am to be ready.
6. Doors for those attending worship will open at 9:45am.
7. We ask that you allow the usher to open the door for you so as to minimize contact with surfaces.
8. You are encouraged to utilize the hand sanitizing stations available at both entrances upon arriving for worship.
9. Please refrain from socializing in the hallways before or after service. You are, however, welcome to visit with one another safely outdoors before or after worship.
10. As you arrive, we ask that you check in with our attendant near the center of the Family Life Center. This is to provide records in the event that contact tracing would need to be initiated.
11. Your offering can be placed in the designated receptacle beside the attendant when you arrive.
12. If you require more chairs for your party than are available, please see Pastor Ryan or a member of the task force for assistance.
